Subject: Aguis Exchange Removal of MaC Parked Orders - PRODUCTION

Overview

Aquis Exchange would like to inform members of an upcoming change to the order entry timings of the Market at Close (MaC) in the **Production** environment:

Effective from the start of business on Monday, 1st September 2025, this change will be applied to the London and Zurich markets. For all other markets, the change will take effect from the start of business on Monday, 8th September 2025.

From these dates onwards, MaC Orders will no longer be accepted throughout the trading day and will only be accepted from 1 minute before the scheduled closing auction start time for each market. This will only be a configuration change at Aquis, and there will be no change to MaC functionality.

MaC Orders sent earlier than 1 minute before the scheduled MaC Open time will be rejected with reason 'MARKET_CLOSED' (FIX users) or reason 'Market Is Closed' 10001001 (binary) = 0x89 (hex) (ATP users).

Members can test this in the Test environment using the London market.
